



**A note on ACS 2006-2010:**

Figures from ACS 2006-2010 represent a sample-based product that surveys about 1 in 9 U.S. households over ten years. As such, the ACS must be used with care. ACS figures for the metro area and its larger counties are fairly representative. However, the accuracy of ACS data diminishes with smaller population size. Figures for areas with less than about 5,000 population, and especially those under about 1,500 population, should be used with caution.
